Tra le opzioni di risposta c'è un distrattore, ovvero un'alternativa di risposta che non va selezionata.

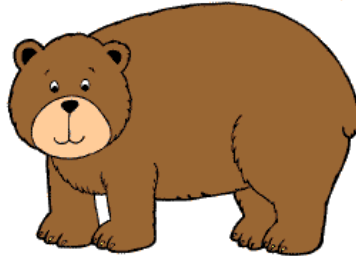
